Official Points of Entry by Flights:	The main point of entry for NOCs travelling to EYOF Győr 2017 are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">o Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport – 153 kms from Győro Győr-Péter Airport – 15,5 kms from Győr

The recommended place of arrival is the Budapest airport. The transfer from Budapest and Péter will be provided by the Organising Committee for free. From the non-official points of entry by flights (Wien, Bratislava) the Organising Committee will charge a fee.

- Visa Information:** EYOF Győr 2017 Organising Committee will provide the 8 European NOCs (Republic of Armenia; Republic of Azerbaijan; Republic of Belarus; Georgia; Republic of Kosovo; Russian Federation; Republic of Turkey; Ukraine) which requires visas for Hungary with support for their visa applications through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade of Hungary.
- NOC Accommodation:** NOCs will be accommodated in Athletes' Villages. AVL I will be situated in the Széchenyi István University Dormitory and AVL II - close to the AVL I - will include 201 flats.
- NOC VIPs & Guest Accommodation:** A number of hotels have been reserved for NOC VIPs & Guests. Accommodation reservations will be carried out via the Registration and Accreditation System.
- Service Centre:** NOC Services will be located in the area of the Széchenyi István University close to the AVL I. This area will also include the Main Accreditation Centre, the Sports Information Centre and the Main Operation Centre. The Main Media Centre will be close to this area, in a different part of this building.
- Local Transportation:** There will be a regular EYOF shuttle service between the accommodations and the competition venues. Teams (BK, HB, VO) will be able to use their dedicated buses.
- NOC Financial Matters:** Participation fee will be 80 euros per day per person for all delegation members.
