Arrivals and departures

The city has a modern international airport with a vast air network, connecting Rio to Brazil and the world. Located at Ilha do Governador, the Tom Jobim International Airport - Rio Galeão (GIG) is about 20 minutes away from the City Center and the South Zone, where most tourist attractions are located, and has fast connection with the region of Barra da Tijuca, through an expressway, the Linha Amarela (Yellow Line).

The second largest airport in the City, Santos Dumont (SDU) airport is located in the City Center, in a privileged location, right by the Guanabara Bay and mainly serves domestic flights. Its main activity is the Rio - Sao Paulo air shuttle service, in addition to connecting Rio to several cities in the country.

Delegations will be welcomed at the terminal of the International airport Tom Jobim with the following signs of the ISF.

Delegations will be accredited at the Olympic Park.

Delegations arriving at the terminal of the International airport Tom Jobim will be transferred to the Olympic Park. Accreditation will proceed by scheduling appointment at Olympic Park.

Departures 27th & 28th August 2023

Delegations will be asked to confirm their departure information no later than 25th August to the LOC office.

Information on the departure of delegation (meeting time and place) will be published on bulletin.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Accredited persons will receive 3 meals per day:

- Breakfast
- Lunch
- Dinner

The LOC will accommodate to specific diets and food restrictions.

1. Three restaurants:

- Olympic Park: Lunch and dinner
- UNIFA: Lunch only.
- Deodoro Park: Lunch only.

2. Breakfast will be served at hotels.

Lunch boxes will be prepared if the program does not fit with the opening hours of the restaurant. During the sport activities (training or official competitions), water bottles will always be provided.

1,5 L water bottles will be available every 48hrs at the hotels for each participant. Water bottles will be available in all competition areas and during meals. The LOC will accommodate to specific diet and food restrictions, which will be specified following Phase 2 each participant.

Time of meals will be communicated to the delegations by the board placed in each accommodation welcome center. Time of meals will not be extended; no solution will be available if participants are not present in the restaurant points during defined opening time.

During the sport activities (training or official competitions), water bottles will always be provided on competition sites.

MEDICAL SERVICES

1. Medical Service Station at the Olympic Park.

2. Ambulance in each competition venue.

3. Extra doctor in each competition area (Olympic Park, UNIFA, and Deodoro Park).

4. Three referral hospitals.

5. Ambulances 24/7 to attend eventual needs at hotels

6. Physiotherapists in the Medical Service Station (Olympic Park) and competition venue.

Medical care will be available to all accredited persons; A doctor with medical staff and an ambulance vehicle will be present at each venue. A team will be available on call 24/7 at all accommodation. Three hospitals are on standby if clinical, surgical, orthopedic or neurological assistance is required.

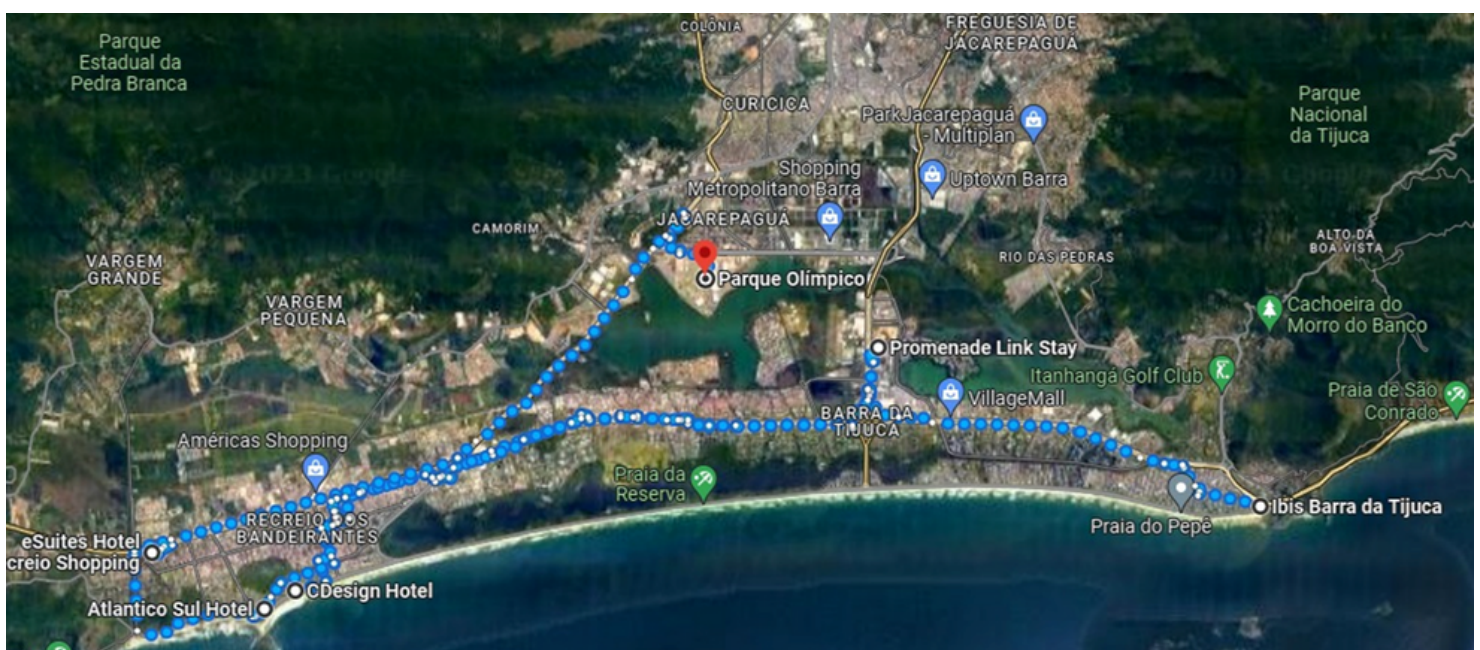

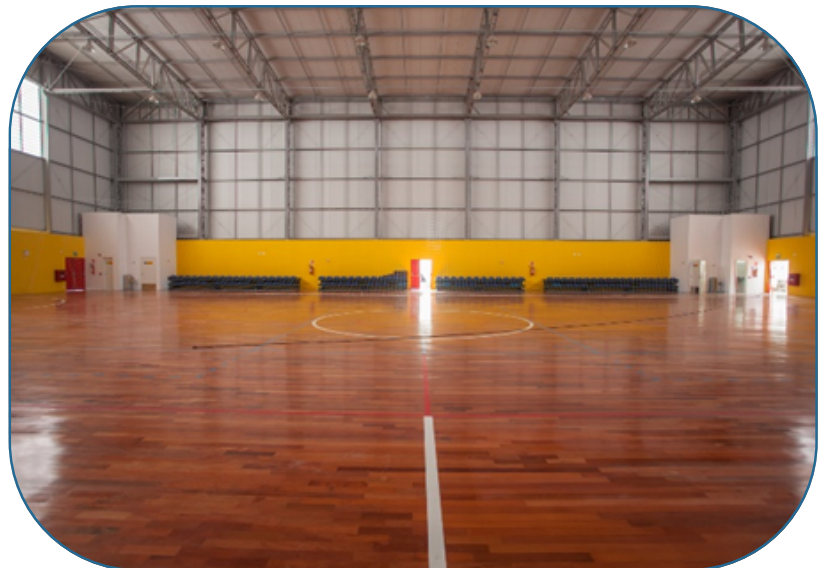

Disciplinary Management

Event Disciplinary Commission

In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, The ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sport Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF event and broadly with any misbehaviours not directly related to technical sport regulations during an ISF event.

The Commission is composed of the ISF Delegate, the TC President of that sport and an LOC representative.

Appeal jury

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition. The Appeal Jury is composed of the Member of the ISF Technical Commission, one member of the Local Organising Committee, and the Head Field of Play Official.

Appeals

Appeals involving results or any matter not concerning discipline will be heard by the Appeal Jury. The appeal must be lodged within 15 minutes of the incident and be submitted in English. The payment of amount 50€ must accompany the appeal and is to be paid to LOC in cash. This payment will be refunded only if the appeal is upheld or at the discretion of the Appeal Jury. In the case of an unsuccessful appeal, the payment will be retained by the ISF.

Cultural Programme

Cultural Visit

The cultural day will take place in the sights presenting the cultural and historical richness of the city of Rio de Janeiro. The schedule of the Cultural Day will be communicated to the participating delegations prior to the event.

Nations Night

The Nations Night will take place at 23rd August in the Arena Carioca 1.

The Nations Night encourages exchanges between the different cultures of the participating countries. During the Nations Night, each delegation is entitled to have a booth to present themselves, in a fair atmosphere.

Delegations are free to bring any material for presenting themselves at their booth: art crafts, visual materials, food, drinks (no alcohol), pins, etc.

Delegations that so wish, can perform on stage to present a dance, song or video typical of their country - maximum 03 minutes. If nations wish to participate in this show, please inform the LOC and provide music/video in MP3/MP4 format by naming the file "nameofcountry.songtitle.MP3/MP4" by sending it to the email: entretenimento@gymnasiade.org.br



Accreditation /Registration

The Accreditation Centre will be located in the Olympic Park.

It will be open all day long on 18th and 19th august.

All delegations, coming either with their own means of transport or with the LOC's means of transport from the airport, are expected to arrive directly to be accredited at the: Olympic Park.

During accreditation, the Head of Delegation must be present. He/she can be accompanied by a coach or by an additional adult. No other member of the delegation shall be admitted to the accreditation room. Please note, that the accreditation process may be subject to change. Any relevant changes will be communicated to the registering delegation prior to the event.

During accreditation, the following *documents will be checked:

Identification form (valid ID/passport): The passport (or ID card) bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth for each member of the delegation

Proof of payment: proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges. To help the LOC to correctly process your payment, please complete the “payment overview” form (downloadable from ERAS after the completion of registration) and send it to the LOC by e-mail prior to your arrival at the event.

Please note, that the accreditation process may be subject to change. Any relevant changes will be communicated to the registering delegation prior to the event.

Prior to your arrival, the following documents are to be uploaded to the ISF ERAS system or ISF Server, by Monday the 7th August:

(Further instructions will be provided directly to all registered delegations)

- **Identification Form (ERAS):** (valid ID/passport): The passport (or ID card) bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth for each member of the delegation
- **Payment Overview (ISF Server):** Overview of the remaining balance to be paid in accordance to with the composition of your delegation. Sent directly to you with the Bulletin 2, you will have an excel document, which you must fill in with all requested information. Once complete, please upload to the ISF Server, following the instructions sent to you.
- **Insurance (ISF Server):** the document certifying that the entire delegation is covered by an insurance. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.
- **School Certificate (ISF Server):** the ISF School Certificate form signed by the School Headmaster or the legitimate School Sport Entity/representative (downloadable from ERAS following the registration of all individuals).
- **Event Consent Form (ISF Server):** the use of image and anti-doping consent form of each competitor, signed by the competitor's parent or legal guardian if he/she is a minor (downloadable from ERAS after the end of registration)
- **Field of Play Official Certificate (ISF Server):** please bring the original/copy of the field of play official certificate to accreditation. A scan of the document will have to be uploaded on ERAS during registration phase 2.

Please bring all participant passports to the Accreditation Centre. Accreditations cards will be handed to the Heads of Delegations at the end of the process, once all documents are in order for each participant.

Balance fee payment

In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the event will follow the rates indicated in the table below. All rates are per night.

ISF Levy

An additional ISF levy per delegation member must be paid together with the balance of the participation fee.

- 50€ for ISF members
- 100€ for non-ISF members

Gala Dinner

A charity gala dinner is organised during the event. All Heads of Delegation are expected to take part in the dinner. The gala dinner fee is 50€/person, to be paid together with the final balance. The dress code is formal. More information on the Gala Dinner will be given to the heads of the delegation at arrival. Participation to the gala dinner will be declared over the registration process Phase 2.

Final Balance

The final balance payment is the participation fee minus the deposit that has already been paid.

It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

The ISF will provide to Heads of Delegation with the necessary information to register the athletes of their delegation for the different educational workshops. Each school athlete could participate in several educational workshops. In the next bulletins, you will have all information regarding the educational programme proposed by the ISF Academy.

By participating to this educational , programme, the participants will receive an official certificate of participation from the ISF Academy



Safeguarding Children in Sport:

We believe that children have the inner resources if educated, to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behaviour such as racism, gender inequity or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react in facing it.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to be able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

Using storytelling, technical basic information, and fostering discussion, the Safeguarding workshop aims to give a clear understanding of the issues surrounding safeguarding in sport. It also aims to give youngsters the knowledge to identify and name abusive behaviours and understand how to react in such cases.

And finally, this class aims to give young people the tools to understand that it's not their fault, that they can ask for help, and where to find help.

Anti-doping Education:

Anti-doping education is of the utmost importance for young people due to several compelling reasons and we believe that young people have the inner resources to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behaviour such as doping. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react if facing it. Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to be able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

Anti-doping education goes beyond the realm of sports. It serves as a platform to impart valuable life lessons and cultivate ethical values in young individuals. By emphasizing the importance of honesty, integrity, and personal responsibility, anti-doping education contributes to the moral development of young athletes. It encourages them to make informed choices, stand up against cheating, and develop a strong sense of integrity that extends beyond the realm of sports and into other aspects of their lives. anti-doping education plays a crucial role in shaping the attitudes and behaviours of young people involved in sports.

Educating them about the risks, consequences, and ethical implications of doping, promotes health, fair play, and integrity while providing them with the necessary tools to make informed decisions that align with their long-term well-being and athletic aspirations.

The law and the rules are important, but it is not just rules that safeguard our sport for clean athletes, but also the measures and processes that help put those rules into action. We must all play our part in promoting fair play and that means gaining an appreciation of what leads to certain decisions being made.

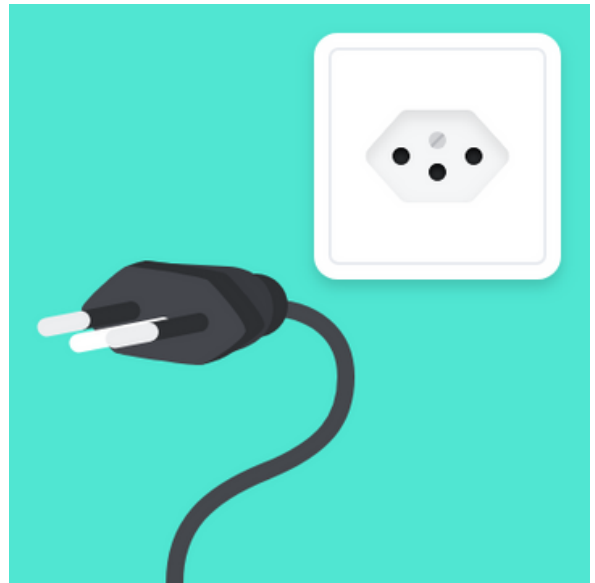
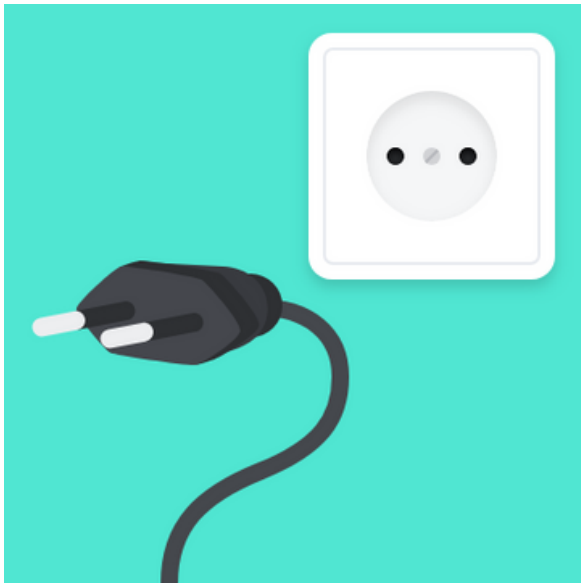
