Dear Olympic friends,


What a wonderful message you are sending from Bahrain to the world: sport brings everyone together.

### TRANSPORTATION


#### **DETAILS**

There will be schedule bus service according to the sport program and other non sport activities. A designated board will be placed at the hotel where all information will be published daily.

This bus services will be used for various purposes, including transportation to training and competition venues, arrivals and departures, as well as for attending the opening and closing ceremonies.

Additionally, it will be available for cultural and educational activities.

## ARRIVALS INFORMATION

We extend a warm welcome to your esteemed delegation to Manama, the host city of this year's ISF Gymnasiade. To ensure a seamless start to your stay, please find below the step-by-step process for your arrival:

#### **Arrival at International Bahrain Airport:**

- Upon your delegation's arrival at International Bahrain Airport, a bus will be stationed outside the terminal.
- A courteous team member will be there to guide you to the bus, which will be ready to transport your delegation to the designated hotel.

#### **Transfer to Tournament Hotel:**

- The bus will provide a comfortable journey to the hotel where your delegation will be accommodated for the duration of the Event.
- Upon arrival at the hotel, our staff will be on hand to assist with check-in and ensure your delegation settles in smoothly.

#### **Accreditation Process for Delegations:**

- The day following your arrival, we have arranged a special transport for the Head of Delegation to Accreditation centre.
- Once the accreditation is completed, the Head of Delegation will be promptly returned to their hotel.
- We kindly ask you to bring all passports and other relevant documents that are needed for the accreditation.
- Please note that all delegation that have not settled the payment of all costs (accommodation, ISF levy, ISF academy, missing referees) will not be able to participate in competition until all costs are settled.

## SECURITY INFORMATION

#### Mission:

The Ministry of Interior will undertake all security arrangements during the 2024 ISF GYMNIASIADE Bahrain thus to ensure Public Safety, Order, and Comprehensive Protection, as well as the safe movement of Visitors and Participants in the event. This includes all Sports Facilities and Venues where competitions will take place, in addition to ensuring Accommodation official Delegations and Teams participating in the event.

#### **Security Committee:**

- Security Measures at Bahrain International Airport:
  - Security presence at Bahrain International Airport to monitor and ensure the procedures for the arrival and departure of participants in the event.
- Security Measures for Hotels and Accommodation:
  - Securing the Hotels and Accommodation sites approved by the organizing committee for the event.
  - Securing the residential floors, entrances and exits of the hotels.
  - Securing parking areas and nearby locations of the hotels.
  - Securing the roads leading to and from the accommodation sites.
  - Establishing security offices in all accommodation hotels.
- Security Measures for Sports Facilities:
  - Patrolling sports facilities.
  - Deploying police officers at sports facilities.



#### **EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

#### SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT

We believe that children have the inner resources if educated, to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behavior such as racism, gender inequity or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people in order for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react if facing it.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

Using storytelling, technical basic information, and fostering discussion, the Safeguarding workshop aims to give a clear understanding of the issues surrounding safeguarding in sport. It also aims to give youngsters the knowledge to identify and name abusive behaviours and understand how to react in such cases.

And finally, this class aims to give young people the tools to understand that it's not their fault, that they can ask for help, and where to find help.

#### **EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

#### MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING IN SPORT

In a world where 1 in 5 children faces mental health challenges—yet many do not receive the care they need, we believe that granting young people access to information about mental health is crucial for empowering them to understand and manage their well-being, especially in sports.

This issue is more urgent than ever. It's essential for adolescents to have accurate and relevant information at their fingertips.

ISF has decided to include this important topic in its educational activities, recognizing the need to present these complex issues in a way that resonates with youths.

This workshop will focus on the importance of discussing mental health in the sports context, emphasizing that mental health is just as essential as physical health. Participants will learn that physical performance cannot thrive without mental resilience, highlighting the interconnectedness of how we feel physically and emotionally.

It will address common challenges young athletes face, highlighting the pressures that can impact how they feel. Participants will learn about the positive effects of sports and, through discussions on recognizing signs of distress and using visuals to show helpful actions, they will receive practical advice on how to support themselves and their friends during tough times. This workshop aims to equip young people with the knowledge and tools they need to deal with mental health issues in sports, creating a supportive community where they feel comfortable seeking help and helping each other.




#### **FUN & SKILLS ZONE**
